<p style="text-align: center;"> <i>St. Luke's Church, Klej Grange, is a small country chapel, three bays wide by four bays deep. It is a frame structure built on a brick foundation. A corner stone has the date 1891 inscribed. Clapboard painted white covers the whole Church, The only entrance is on the west facade. It has a double door with semicircular transom glazed with colored glass in someone's memory. All of the windows have clear panes. They are very tall, narrow windows with the upper part of the double hung sash being semicircular with radiating muntins. The windows also have keystone trim and green louvered shutters. There is a plain overhanging eave on all sides of the roof. The chancel is a three-sided pod on the east end, lighted by two small windows with colored glass.</i> </p> <p style="text-align: center;"> <i>It is of interest because of the simple Georgian style</i> </p>
