Based on the information available, 104 Hickory Street does not appear to meet the criteria for inclusion in the Maryland Register. The property is located well outside the Pocomoke City Historic District (prior determination of eligibility) and in an area that is unlikely to constitute a district. The modest two story, cross gable house with an "L" shaped plan is an extremely common type, particularly on the Eastern Shore. The house is undistinguished in terms of architecture and is not known to have been associated with any significant events or persons.





