NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC Yes</p> <p>The Chapel of the Holy Cross is a small frame building on brick foundation built in 1850 in the Gothic revival style. The entrance is on a small vestibule on the north gable. It has double doors with a lancet arch above filled with louvered effect clapboards. To the west of the vestibule is a hyphen with three stain glass lancet windows, connected to a bell tower which apparently has three floor levels. The upper level is completely open with low pierced work railing and braces at the corner posts. There is a pyramidal roof with small wood cross atop. The tower has one lancet window on three sides of first story, a double lancet stain-glass window on second story. At the corners of the second story are applied pilasters. Between stories is a very small pent eave. In the foundation of the tower is a corner stone with the following inscription:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Chapel of the Holy Cross Erected 1850 Tower added 1887</p> <p>The nave of the chapel is three bays deep (one wide). It is covered with clapboard and has an "A" roof with "kick" at the eaves. The cornice is a modified wood cove. Each of the side windows have lancet arches like the front door, louvered shutters, six over four sash. Above the main door is small lancet window.</p> <p>The sanctuary is beyond the nave and has a three-part Gothic stain glass window on its gable.
