

A large exterior chimney is built on the east gable and is flanked by a window on each floor. Above the front door, which has a rectangular transom, is a second story bay window and a gable in the "A" roof, both apparently were later additions. The windows on both stories have nine over six sash and louvered shutters, though the upper windows are smaller. There is an 'L' to the rear dating probably from the time the gable and bay window were installed.</p>
