

It is built of frame covered with clapboard on a brick foundation. Its gable facade is on West Market Street. It has double door with transom, flanked by two colored glass windows with lancet arches. The window along the sides of the building are rectangular and the two center bays are composed of two windows each. To the front of the nave is the sanctuary.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">It is one of the least impressive church buildings in Worcester County but because it is preserved by the Worcester County Historical Society in memory of Julia A. Purnell, we include it in our survey of buildings for the county.</p>
